2019 Theme: Leading the Way!

This year will mark the 5th annual Iowans with Disabilities in Action Make Your Mark! Conference. The last four conferences have brought Iowans with disabilities, direct care support professionals, parents/family member and other disability advocates together to develop skills to increase their civic and political engagement. This year our focus is on Leadership –

- What does leadership really mean?
- How can I use the skills I have or what skills do I need to work on to be a leader?
- Do I always have to lead or sometimes should I follow?

The idea of leadership can be intimidating! This conference will help those who want to be more involved get started and those who are already active to continue to develop their skills.

Target Audience

The conference is intended for Iowans with disabilities who want to become more civically engaged in their communities. While we anticipate that parents/family members, caregivers/direct support staff, service providers, and others affected by disability will be in attendance at the conference, the target audience for presentations is Iowans with disabilities.

Presentation Format

The conference will offer 75 minute breakout sessions. Presentations should address one of the presentation categories and incorporate the “Leading the Way” theme. Preference will be given to presentations that are interactive, include at least one presenter with a disability and provide specific actions that participants can use to make their own mark.

Room set-up

Breakout session rooms will be set in rounds or “classroom” style to accommodate 50-to-60 participants. If your proposed session requires a different set-up, this must be indicated on the application. We cannot guarantee that we will be able to accommodate your preferred arrangement, but we will do our best.

Topics/Tracks

We are interested in reviewing presentation proposals that focus on developing leadership skill to increase civic and political participation among Iowans with disabilities.

Presentation Categories: Presentations should focus on one of the following categories:

- Community Inclusion
- Advocacy
- Volunteerism
- Grassroots Organizing
- Employment

Proposal Review Process

All completed proposals will be reviewed by the Iowans with Disabilities in Action team.

The committee will use the following review criteria:

- The presentation focuses on one of the presentation categories and follows the “Leading the Way” theme
- The presentation includes at least one person with a disability as a presenter
- The presentation leaves participants with specific actions they can take to make their own mark
- The presentation includes interactive activities for participants
- The presenter’s qualifications and experience

We reserve the right to request modifications to a proposal before a final decision is made. We also reserve the right to combine presentations with similar topics in one session. Presenters will be notified in advance if this should occur.
