Re: Records Request

Dear Mr. Ripke:

Following is the Washoe County School District's ("District") response to your letter received by Scott Reynolds, Chief Student Support Services Officer, on September 28, 2012. Your correspondence requested the following:

- 1. "Can you send me a list of all the Schools that have a Special Education Program in it?
- 2. "For those schools can you tell me what program they have (CLS, SIP, etc.)"
- 3. "Can you also let me know how many special education classrooms are in the school district for each school?"

In general, every school in the District provides special education services for students with disabilities who are in attendance. In addition, each school zone has access to specialized programs if a student requires more restrictive services available at another setting.

All middle and high schools in our District are expected to provide Social Intervention Programming (SIP) as well as Comprehensive Life Skills (CLS) programming. Depending on a particular student's needs, those services would be provided in the least restrictive environment (general education classroom) on those middle and high school campuses, or in a more restrictive setting (increased time in a special education setting) at the child's school.

The location of the services varies from year to year and the programs can move within the school year, depending on the needs of students and the population being served. As you

probably know, if a student needs a program that is not available at his or her neighborhood school, the District must arrange to provide those services in another setting and the District makes the final decision as to the school location that will provide the service.
