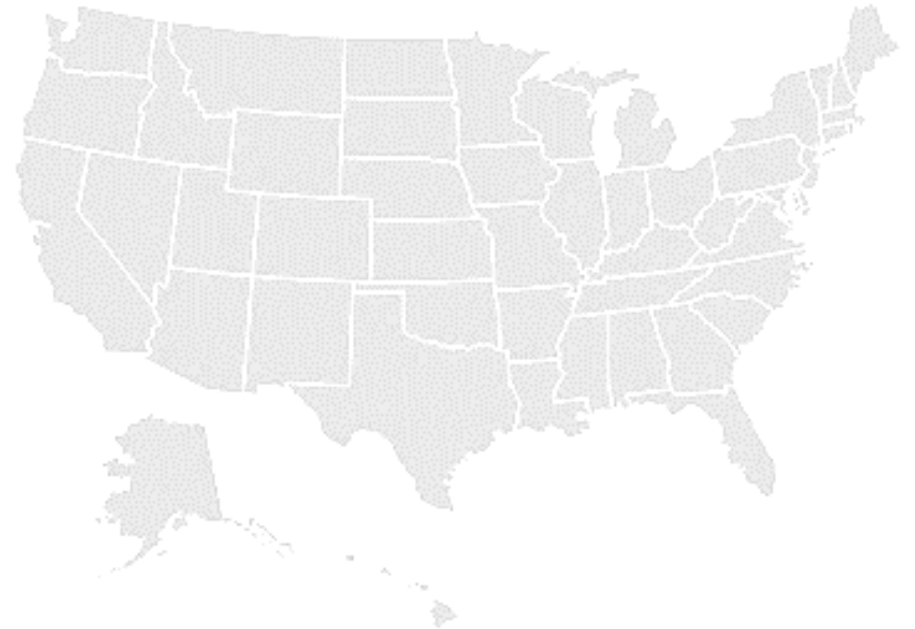

Health Center Program Fast Facts

- Nearly **1,400** health centers operate nearly **13,000** service delivery sites nationwide
- Nearly **30 million** patients
- Health centers provide **patient-centered, comprehensive, integrated care** by offering a range of services:
 - Primary medical, oral, and mental health services
 - Substance use disorder and medication-assisted treatment (MAT) services
 - Enabling services such as case management, health education, and transportation

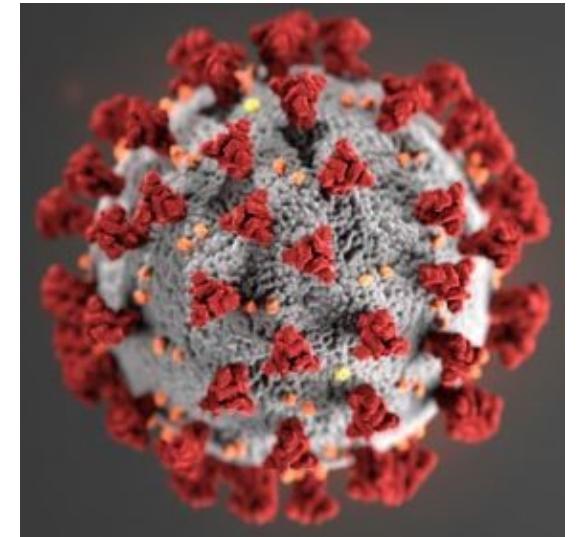

Health Centers and COVID-19 Response

Health centers are on the front lines, delivering critical services, including:

- COVID-19 testing, treatment, vaccinations and masks.
- Monitoring and managing COVID-19 symptoms to alleviate burden on emergency rooms and hospitals.
- Coordinating with local and state health departments to support a unified and comprehensive public health response.
- Providing ongoing essential primary care services to patients with ongoing primary care and mental health care needs, including continuing essential services needed to manage conditions that put patients at increased risk for COVID-19 complications.



Health Center COVID-19 Direct Allocation Programs

To ensure our nation's underserved communities and those disproportionately affected by COVID-19 have equitable access to critical COVID-19 response tools, HRSA is making the following resources to health centers and rural health clinics:

- Adult and Pediatric Vaccines
- Diagnostic Testing Supplies, including at home, self-testing kits
- Therapeutics, including oral antiviral pills
- N95 Face Masks
