## Training Description:

Sexual health and sexual self-advocacy are areas that are too often overlooked for individuals with disabilities. Many practitioners feel uncomfortable with the content, lack access to resources or training, or only consider sexuality education after instances of abuse or unsafe sexually-related behaviors occur. As practitioners whose work can span across ages, environments, and disabilities, behavior analysts are in the unique position to lead access to comprehensive sexuality education and promote sexual self-advocacy. Rather than viewing sexuality education as unapproachable, this training will demonstrate how to conceptualize components of sexuality education into more familiar territory.
