You can have a plan from Vocational Rehabilitation to help you find and keep a job in your community.

Providers



Sheltered workshops can have help to change so they can support people in community jobs.



Oregon will help new providers support people with IDD to have jobs in their communities at minimum wage and up.

Over 7,000 workers with IDD will have access to supports for community jobs.



Oregon will expect that all people with IDD work an average of 20 hours a week if they want to.

*Please note: Before the proposed settlement can move forward, the court must approve it.
